The expansion of international partnerships continued, with a number of memoranda of understanding and cooperation signed in 2023, including with the Kyrgyz Republic, the Kazakhstan International Development Agency "KazAID", the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Eurasian Development Bank. Under the framework of the Digital Almaty 2023 international forum, a memorandum was signed with the National Information Agency (NIA) of the Republic of Korea.

During the year we have successfully enhanced our products and services in response to new market demands and customer needs. Special attention has been paid to innovation and the development of advanced solutions that not only meet, but exceed the expectations of our users.

A significant contribution to automation has been reached through availability of more than 90% of public services in electronic format.

Another landmark achievement was the creation of the Qaztech platform along with development and data management tools, providing uniform standards at every stage of the life cycle of government information systems, significantly facilitating the creation, modernization and improvement of information systems.

I would like to emphasize that all our successes and achievements are the result of the effective and coordinated work of the Company's employees, the members of the Board of Directors, the Management Board, and our partners.

I would like to express my gratitude to all the employees of National Information Technologies JSC for their effective work, and to our partners for their trust and long-term cooperation.

Together, we are shaping a future where technology becomes a trusted tool for solving the most challenging tsks.

National Information Technologies JSC plays a key role in the development of information and communication technologies in the country.

The Company is engaged in the creation and implementation of various digital solutions and services for the public sector, which contributes to the automation of government processes and the improvement of the quality of services provided to the public.

International cooperation was actively developed during the reporting year. In addition to a number of memoranda of understanding signed with the Kyrgyz Republic, the Kazakh Agency for International Development (KazAID), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Eurasian Development Bank, and the Republic of Korea, the Company concluded contracts for the supply of its products to the Republic of Tajikistan, which opened up new prospects for the Company's development. The Company also participated in Digital Bridge 2023 and Digital Almaty 2023, where it showcased its solutions.

The past year has been a time of challenges, opportunities and significant achievements for us. In the fast-changing world of digital technologies, we have successfully maintained and even strengthened our leading positions, thanks to the well-coordinated work of our team and the trust of our customers.

Thus, by the end of 2023, 12 new services were added to the eGov portal in the fields of land relations, transport and communication, finance and social security, a total of 342 services became available, over 32 million of services have been delivered and the number of portal users exceeds 90% of the economically active population. The "Digital Data" and "Surveys" components have been introduced to the eGov Mobile application, the "Digital Documents" component has been modified and the number of available digital documents is constantly increasing, the "Military Registration" section has been created, a total of 205 services are available, 12.8 million services have been delivered, 8.8 million users are registered in the mobile application.

Another success for the Company was the recognition of the Smart Data Ukimet project at the ADV conference held in Vienna, Austria, where it was among the TOP-5 projects and nominated for the Data Excellence Hero Award, given to professionals in the field of working with big data.

In fulfilment of the Head of State's address to the people of Kazakhstan, the Qaztech platform was created, a cloud solution with development, data management and security tools. As part of the launch of the QazTech platform, three information systems were migrated and one service was created: a single platform of government agencies' websites; a showcase of Smart Bridge services; the website of NITEC JSC; a service for limiting participation in gambling and/or betting, which is available in the Egov Mobile application.

To create a fault-tolerant infrastructure for GovTech, the Company acquired a new Data Center for 200 racks in Astana. The new Data Center provides a level of reliability – TIER3 Uptime Institute.

The Company is constantly working to improve the quality of its services, and in the reporting year it scored 4.44 out of a possible 5.00 points in a survey conducted by the Ministry of Digital Development and Aerospace Industry of the Republic of Kazakhstan on the quality of services provided by NITEC JSC to government agencies and local executive bodies. These activities help us to identify vulnerabilities and focus our attention on them.

I would like to acknowledge the contribution of each and every employee of the Company to our common cause. Your dedication, professionalism and commitment to excellence have become the foundation of our success. I would like to express my gratitude to the members of the Board of Directors and to the Sole Shareholder - our achievements are a collective achievement.

Together we will conquer all heights and I am optimistic about the future of our Company.

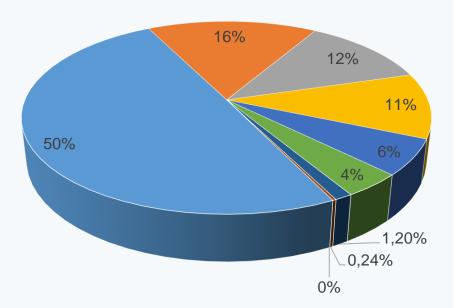

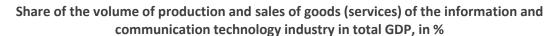

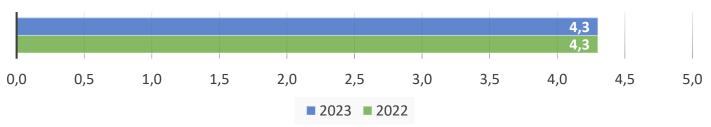

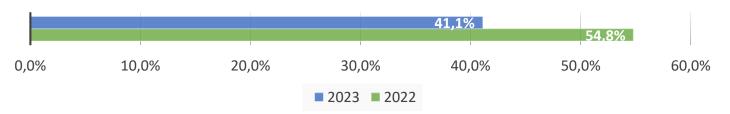




Volume of the IT market in the ICT industry, billion KZT



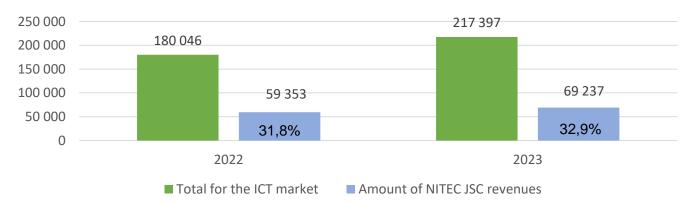
Share of IT services in the total volume of the IT market, in %

Volume of IT services provided to state-owned enterprises, million KZT

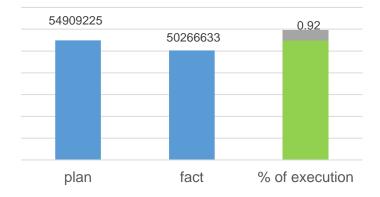

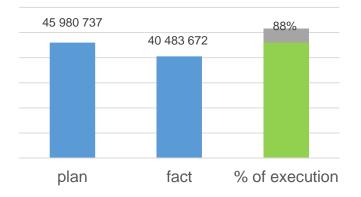

FOR 21 INVESTMENT PROJECTS in 2023 (fact)

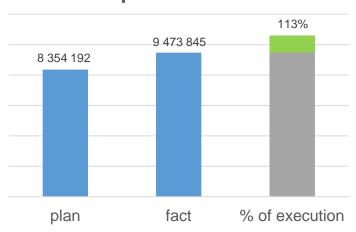
Revenue (ths. KZT, excluding VAT)



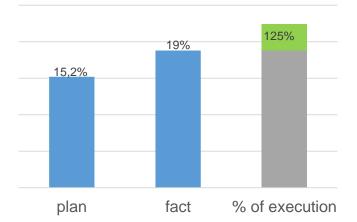
Expenses (ths. KZT, excluding VAT)

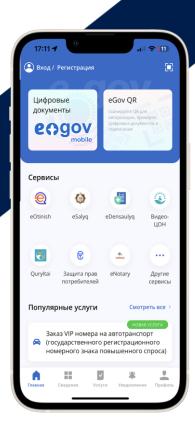

The **Smart Data Ukimet** project was nominated for the **Data Excellence Hero Award**, which is given to professionals in the field of working with big data, during participation at the **ADV Conference**, which took place in Vienna in April 2023. Following the presentation of the project to the expert jury, Smart Data Ukimet entered the **TOP 5** among more than 50 projects and was highly appreciated by international experts



Work has been carried out on the connection and maintenance of 83 databases of government agencies` information systems and the data in the databases of government agencies` information systems connected to the SDU IAS has been updated.

The analytical case "Analysis of citizens' registration in the waiting list to receive housing from the public housing fund or housing rented by a local executive body in a private housing fund" was implemented, thanks to which about 300 thousand people being illegally put on the waiting list were identified and the waiting time was potentially halved.

The following analytical dashboards were also implemented: "Monitoring the discrepancy of information in databases of information systems of government agencies", "Youth of the NEET category", "Monitoring the ecological state of the environment", "Analysis of the equity market of the Republic of Kazakhstan" and "Automation of jury selection".

Services for the proactive provision of benefits and allowances have been implemented.

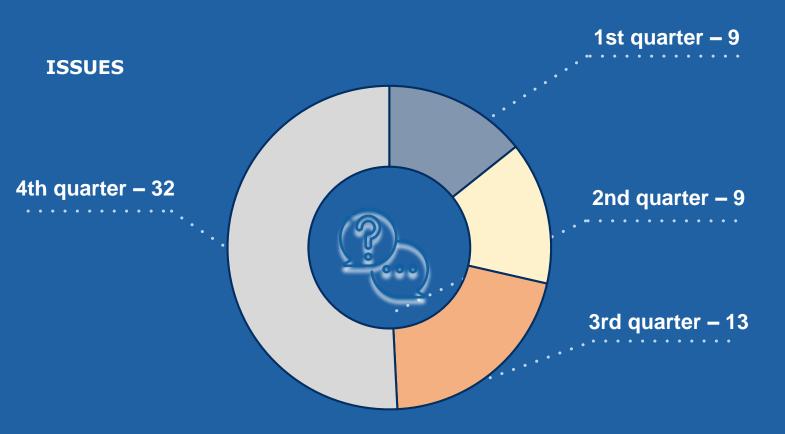

REMUNERATION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Pursuant to the Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On Joint-Stock Companies", Independent Directors – Members of the Board of Directors of the Company are paid remuneration and compensated for expenses related to the performance of their functions based on the the decision of the Sole Shareholder. The amount of such remuneration and compensation is determined by the decision of the Sole Shareholder of the Company.

In accordance with the procedure established by the Company, remuneration for the performance of duties of a member of the Board of Directors is paid for participation in meetings of the Board of Directors and Committees of the Board of Directors of the Company.

The total amount of remuneration paid to the members of the Board of Directors of the Company for the year ended December 31, 2023 amounted to KZT 17,077,500.

COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Pursuant to the Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On Joint-Stock Companies", Committees of the Board of Directors should be established in the Company to consider the most important issues and prepare recommendations to the Board of Directors.

The Committees of the Board of Directors consider the following issues:

- 1) strategic planning;

- 3) internal audit;
- 4) social issues;
- 5) other issues stipulated by the Company's in-house documents.

The Committees of the Board of Directors consist of members of the Board of Directors and experts having relevant professional knowledge to work on a particular committee.

The Committee of the Board of Directors is headed by a member of the Board of Directors. Independent directors become the heads (chairmen) of the Committees of the Board of Directors and their responsibilities include consideration of the issues provided for in subclauses 1) to 4).

In accordance with the Corporate Governance Code of National Information Technologies JSC, Committees are established to conduct in-depth analysis and make recommendations on a number of important issues prior to their consideration by the Board of Directors. Pursuant to the decision of the Board of Directors of the Company, three Committees of the Board of Directors have been established and operate on a permanent basis in the Company:

- 1. Audit Committee;
- 2. Compensation and Nominating Committee;
- 3. Strategic Planning Committee

CORPORATE RISK MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The main goal of the current corporate risk management system of National Information Technologies JSC (hereinafter - Company) is to achieve an optimal balance between the growth of the Company, its profitability and risks, as well as to ensure sustainable development within the framework of implementation of strategic plans and achievement of established goals.

Risk management in the Company is regulated by the Risk Management Policy; Risk Identification, Assessment and Management Rules, as well as in-house rules and procedures developed in accordance with the best practices in the field of risk management such as ISO 31000 "Risk Management - Principles and Guidelines", ISO 9001:2015 "Quality management Systems. Requirements", ISO/IEC 27001:2013 "ISMS. Requirements" and ISO/IEC 20000-1:2018 "Information Technology (IT). Service Management".

Risk management is a management process and is integrated into all of the Company's business processes through the implementation and use of risk management models and tools and assignment in the Company's relevant regulatory documents of the responsibilities to the participants in the Company's risk management system and the procedure for carrying out work within the system.

THE CORPORATE RISK MANAGEMENT SYSTEM OF THE COMPANY IS A MULTI-LEVEL STRUCTURE:



First level - Sole Shareholder (makes strategic risk management decisions).

Second level - Board of Directors (determines the risk management policy). An Audit Committee has been established under the Board of Directors, which considers issues related to the control of the Company's risk management system.

Third level - Management Board (responsible for organizing an effective risk management system to ensure compliance with corporate policies).

Fourth level- Risk Management Service (responsible for organizing and coordinating the risk identification and assessment process).

Fifth level - structural divisions represented by each employee manage risks at the level of business process owners.

Internal Audit Service regularly evaluates the effectiveness of the corporate risk management system

CORPORATE RISK MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

In order to work effectively with risk factors and to stimulate the communication process in the Company, a **unified risk classification** has been introduced in the context of functional groups and subgroups of risks and their components, indicating the risk assessment:

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF COMPANY

The decision of the Board of Directors of the Company approved the Sustainable Development Policy No. 13 as of December 19, 2019 and the Action Plan for the Sustainable Development of the Company for 2023 No. 5 as of November 14, 2023. The foundations of sustainable development are to achieve the strategic goals of the Company without compromising its long-term sustainability, taking into account the interests of the various stakeholders. The Company's sustainable development policy takes into account all the aspects of the Company's activities, including economic, social and environmental aspects.

AS PART OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT POLICY AND ACTION PLAN, THE COMPANY HAS CARRIED OUT THE FOLLOWING WORK:

According to the 2023 results, 19 out of 24 tasks have been completed, 5 tasks have not been completed and 1 task has been postponed to 2024.

In implementation of economic aspects:

- Development Plan of National Information Technologies JSC for 2024-2033 was approved by the resolution of the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan as of December 19, 2023 No. 1145;
- A separate accounting system has been introduced;
- Measures have been taken to monitor the quality of the services provided, to ensure the smooth functioning of the information systems and the e-Gov information and communication infrastructure, to train staff and users, to survey customers and to determine the level of satisfaction with the Company's services as part of improving the quality of the services provided by the Company;
- Agreements have been concluded with international companies for the Company's services (3 memoranda, 3 license agreements);
- An action plan as of February 23,2022 has been developed and implemented to enhance and promote the image/reputation of the Company.

In terms of social aspects:

- 425 employees were employed, of whom 37 were postgraduate students (8.7%);
- In 2023, 45 team building and recreational events were held;
- On July 28, 2023, the Chairman of the Board approved an action plan for the implementation of a social support programme to improve housing conditions and compensate for kindergarten costs.

In terms of environmental aspects:

 The Company's employees took part in citywide environmental cleanups at the central and regional levels.

TRANSFORMATION PLAN

AREAS AND GOALS

The transformation process aimed at improving internal processes and operational efficiency of the Company was launched in 2023. Introduction of the Scrum methodology was one of the key steps. Two product teams and one cross-functional team were trained in December and began to actively use Scrum principles in their daily activities.







The results of the implementation will become visible in 2024, but the feedback from the training participants has been positive: there has been an improvement in the efficiency and quality of work, and an increase in inter-team interaction.
